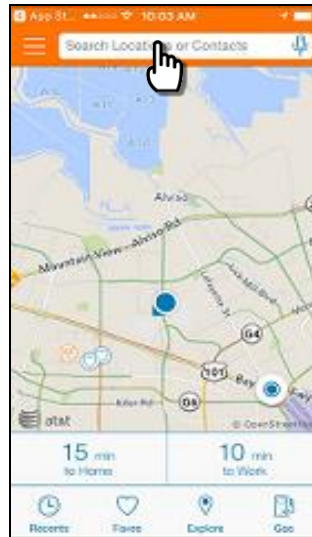

# 1. Drive To



To get GPS directions, select the **Search Bar** from the main menu. Type or speak the address or business name and then tap the actual address or select the done button on text keyboard.

On the next screen, select the drive icon  to see the route planning screen, or input the destination in one of several ways:

- Home / Work Address
- Recents
- Faves
- Explore
- Gas







On the “Route Planning” screen, you can wait for AT&T Navigator to download the route and choose from 1-3 route options.

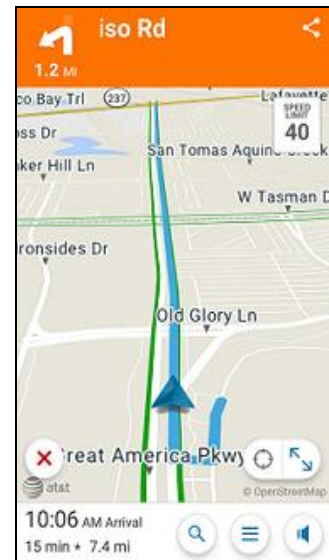
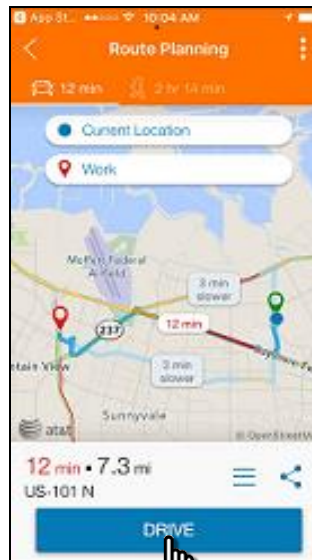
- **Change Route Type** - Select your preferred route style by selecting the  icon.
- **Share ETA** – Tap  to send the status and progress of your travel via text to an individual or group.

Tap **Drive** to start your trip.

Once the route is loaded, you will get visual and audible directions to your destination.


During navigation, you have the following options:

- **Route & Traffic** – Tap  to view a turn-by-turn summary of your route or simply swipe left to avoid a segment and recalculate route.
- **Map Summary** – Tap  to view a map summary of your route.
- **Search** – Tap  to search for a business along your route.
- **Stop** – Tap screen and select  to cancel the turn-by-turn directions of the generated route.



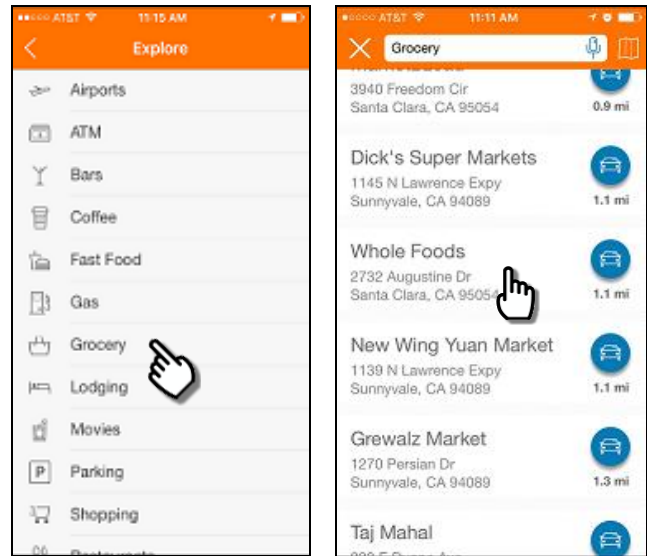
## 2. Explore

AT&T Navigation lets you access millions of business listings and phone numbers. Find restaurants, shops, ATMs, and many more.


Tap  **Explore** at the main menu to see a list of business categories.

Begin your search by choosing a category like “Coffee” or “Restaurants.”






Tap a business to view its details on the next screen.

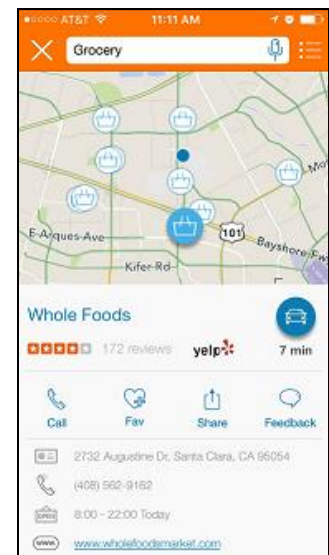


On the Details screen, you will see the business name, its address, and its phone number (if available). Swipe up to view any descriptions and reviews.

To view a map of your search results, tap the Map icon .

In Search Details, you have the following options:

- Drive to the address of the business by tapping the pedestrian icon .
- Select the pedestrian  tab if the location is within walking distance.
- Tap the phone number, if available, to call the business.
- Tap the heart icon  to save the business to Faves.
- Tap **Share**  to send the address to another user.
- Tap **Feedback**  to send feedback about the address.

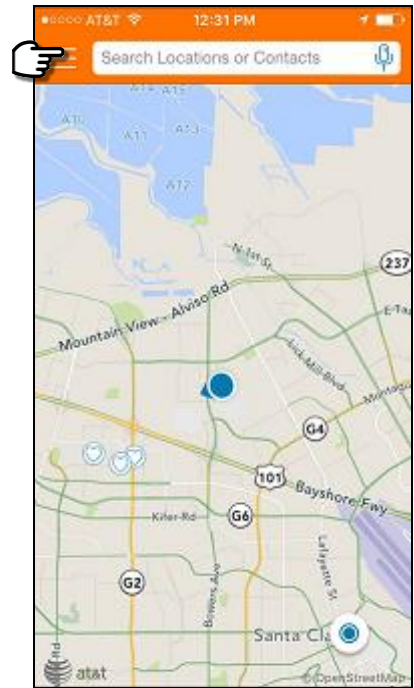




### 3. Maps & Traffic

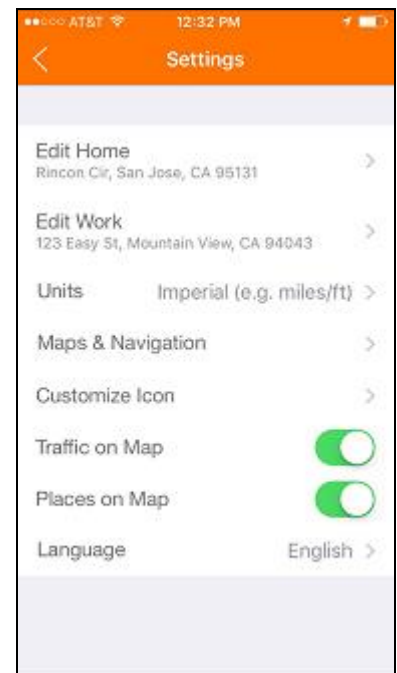
You can easily view a map of your current location or a particular address using the default AT&T Navigator map.

Pan the map by tapping on map and pinching two fingers together to zoom in. You may also spread your pinched fingers apart to view a larger area of the map.

To re-center on your current location, tap the Find Me icon .



To display or hide Traffic conditions, Cameras, or your Favorites on the map, simply tap on the profile button  (displayed on above image), located on the upper left corner. Next, select the  settings button to view the list of options to toggle on or off.



## 4. My Navigation

In “My Navigation” you have the following options:

- **Download Maps** – Download one of the 3 regions, so you may utilize uninterrupted navigation in a poor data location.
- **Settings** –Set your preferences on how you want to use and view AT&T Navigator such as units and route options.
  - Edit Home or Work
  - Units – Miles/ Feet / Km / Meters
  - Maps & Navigation (Route Options, Map Color, Moving Maps, Back Light, Audio Speed Alert, Traffic Incident Alert)
  - Customize icon
  - Traffic on Map
  - Places on Map
  - Language
- **Commute Report** (setup to get a notification if delays exceed 15 mins)
- **Rate AT&T Navigator**
- **Get Help**
- **Feedback**
- **More from AT&T**
- **Terms / privacy / about**
